IMMIGRANTS' CONTRIBUTIONS IN OHIO *AFTER DACA/DAPA*

25,000: Number of Ohioans eligible for DAPA (parents of US citizen or LPR)

10,000 – 10,800: Number of Ohioans eligible for DACA (came to US as a child)

41%: Percent of Ohio undocumented population eligible for DAPA or DACA
